In the Quran

- "Allah there is no God but He. His are the most excellent names." (Ta Ha 20:8)
- "Allah has the most excellent names. So call on Him by His names and shun those who distort them." (al-Araf, 7:180)

In Hadith

 "Allah has 99 names. He who remembers these will certainly enter Paradise." (Sahih Bukhari, Kitab al Da'awat 2,949)




AL HALEEM from Surah al Baqarah 2:225 THE MOST FORBEARING MEANING: TAKING THE TIME TO ACT

AL HALEEM — WHAT WE LEARN

What we learn from this divine attribute are lessons of:

- Tolerance
 - Both with yourself and others
 - Overlook the mistakes of others just as we wish for Allah to overlook our shortcomings
- Patience & accepting things outside of your control
 - Persevere in doing good but be patient while awaiting results
 - For example: the Makkan period of seerah, various prophetic stories & "Rome was not built in a day"
 - Patience with others
- Forgiveness and peaceful coexistence
 - We should remain patient during injustice and hurt caused to us, as Allah is sufficient to take offenders to task.



PRINCIPLES

- These attributes inform our appreciation and understanding of Allah
- When looking at one attribute, which is mind blowing (<u>All</u> Hearing, Aware, <u>Most</u> Merciful, Mighty, The One), imagine how great Allah is when you consider all 99 attributes together! Most probably beyond our comprehension!
- To the extent that we can, we should aim to emulate as many qualities as possible in our lives, e.g.:
 - Being Forgiving... Just... Appreciative... Generous
 - Being Wise... Honorable Truthful... Firm... Steadfast...
